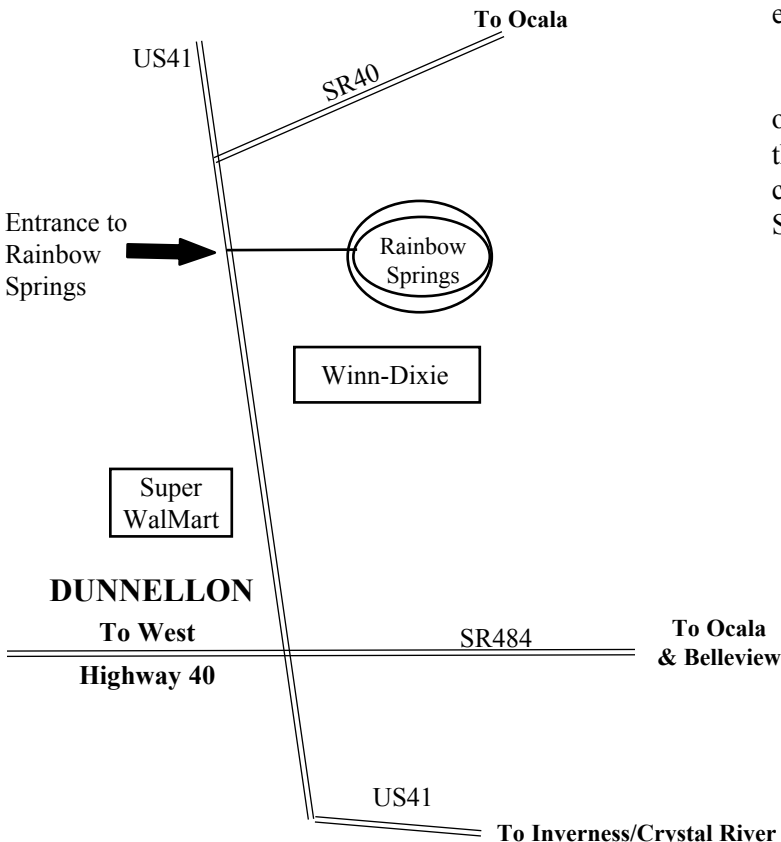
Directions from North Ocala & I-75 - Take SR40
(Silver Spring Blvd) west. From I-75 travel SW about 17
mi. to junction of SR40 and US41. Turn left onto US41. The
entrance to Rainbow Springs is about 1/2 mi on the left.

Directions from South Ocala & Belleview area - Get
onto SR484 and travel west to the junction of SR484 and
US41 in Dunnellon. Turn right at the red light onto US41
and travel through Dunnellon for about 3.8 mi to the
entrance of Rainbow Springs on the right.

Directions from Inverness or Crystal River area. Get
onto US41 North from Inverness toward Dunnellon. At
the light in Dunnellon at the junction of US41 and SR484
continue straight for 3.8mi to the entrance of Rainbow
Springs on the right.

AT RAINBOW SPRINGS: travel on the divided
entrance road for about 8/10 mi. The Park entrance
is just past the railroad tracks on the right side of the
road. Parking is on the left side. Entrance fee is \$2.00
per person. There is wheel chair access to most areas
of the park.

The picnic is being held in the Felburn Pavilion
which is located to the left after you've gone through
the entrance gate. It is behind the gift shop and snack
bar.
